Courier-Journal.Com of Louisville, Kentucky reported the accident as follows: Dini Papapietro died in the operating room at University Hospital at 9:36 pm Friday. An autopsy was done Saturday morning and the cause of death was multiple blunt force injuries, a county deputy coroner said.

Dini was struck about 6:30 pm Friday by a minivan or SUV that fled the scene, Louisville Metro Police said. Police are looking for a white Pontiac Trans Sport minivan or an SUV crossover a witness saw hit her. The vehicle was last seen driving south and may have damage to its front end.

A driver of a pickup truck said that Dini was walking west across Baxter Avenue when she stumbled to the street. The pickup truck had been traveling south on Baxter Avenue and managed to to swerve around Dini. But a van or SUV, which was behind the pickup truck, ran over her. The pickup driver told police that Dini was wearing dark clothing.
