INDONESIA'S TEXTILE ARTS

- Why are the arts of weaving and dyeing recognized among Indonesia's most important cultural expressions?

Roy W. Hamilton, senior curator of Asian and Pacific collections at UCLA's Fowler Museum, explores the many roles in cloth in Indonesian society. With this background in place, he discusses Sumatran textiles now on view, ranging from luxurious silk ikats of the Palembang sultanate to the wildly imaginative supplementary-weft weavings of the Lampung pepper-trading region.

After the lecture, visit "*Sumatra: Textiles from the Dr. Thomas J. Hudak Collection*", on view beginning February 13 in the Museum's Orme Lewis Gallery.

The talk is preceded (from 6:30 to 7:00 in Whiteman Hall) by music from Children of the Mud Volcano, ASU's gamelan orchestra.
